Mrs. M.B. Cureton by deed dated Oct. 24, 1892, and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for said County and State in Deed Book "YY", at page 559. The said Trs. Mourning B. Cureton departed this life leaving of full force her will now on file in the office of the Probate Court said land to her husband, G. W. Cureton for life, with remainder to me, the said James S. Cureton. The said G.W. Cureton died on or about the second day of December 1902, whereby I became the absolute owner of said land. This is a first mort gage on the forty-six and one-half  $(46-\frac{1}{2})$  acre tract still belonging to me and first hereinabove described by courses and distances.
