I, May B. Croxton

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said May B. Croxton  
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

Camp Sevier Lumber & Supply Co.  
in the full and just sum of Eighteen hundred Seventy-five (\$1875.00)  
Dollars, to be paid as follows: \$31.25 on the 21st day of May  
1925 and \$31.25 on the 21st day of each and every  
consecutive month thereafter until paid in full

with interest thereon, from *May B. Croxton* at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum, to be  
computed and paid *semi-monthly*

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,  
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

*less per cent* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or  
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereto had, as will more fully appear).

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, the said *May B. Croxton*

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

*Camp Sevier Lumber & Supply Company*  
according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me*, the said

*May B. Croxton* in hand well and truly paid by the said *Camp Sevier Lumber*  
*& Supply Company*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant,

bargain, sell and release unto the said *Camp Sevier Lumber & Supply*  
*Company*:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land  
situate, lying and being in the county of  
Greenville, state of South Carolina, bounded  
and designated as lot No. 5 of the subdivision  
known as Piedmont Park, according to a  
survey and plat made by C. M. Furniss, Jr.,  
Eng. recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville  
County in Plat Book "F" page 290, and having  
according to said plat, the following metes  
and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on Maple  
Drive corner of lot No. 6 and running  
thence with line of lot No. 6 N. 83-25 W. 225.88 feet to pin; thence S. 64-2 W. 100 feet  
to pin, corner of lot No. 4; thence with  
line of lot No. 4 S. 83-25 E. 225.23 feet to pin  
on Maple Drive; thence with said Maple  
Drive, N. 6-33 E. 100 feet to the beginning  
corner.

Being the same lot of land conveyed to  
me by Camp Sevier Lumber & Supply Company  
by deed dated April 10th, 1925 the same not  
yet recorded.
