computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Five Dollars besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind, all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

bargain, sell and release unto the said P. C. Paag

and 2 of Block C of the subdivision of the Thurston land
by J. B. Rogers Surveyor date April 1912; the said two
lots having in the aggregate the following metes and
bounds: Beginning at a stake on the east side
of Nova Street at corner of lot of J. B. Thurston and
running thence along said street N. 15 1/2 W. 136 feet
to a stake thence N. 81 E. 26 feet to a stake on
the S. E. property line thence along said line S. 6 E. 136 feet to a stake thence S.
81 W. 213. 84 feet to the beginning point on said Nova Street.
