

## THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

That L. M. Morris

of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, L. M. Morris, the said L. M. Morris, day of November, 1925,  
 in and by himself certain note or obligation, bearing the 11th day of November, 1925,  
 indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate,  
 duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of \$1200.00 Dollars,  
 with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 11th day of November, A. D. 1925,

Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock, and .640 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of \$16.80 Dollars, \$12.00 Dollars,
