WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of

One Thousand and

Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight
per cent. per annum, payable weekly,

the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece or parcels of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

*In Greenville Township in the city of Greenville
on the south side of Stone Avenue said
having the following courses and distances:
Beginning at a iron pine at the corner of
the lot of J. A. Berry and running thence
with his line N. 05° 26' W. 175 feet to an
iron pine, thence N. 83° 13' W. parallel with
Stone Avenue 70 feet to an iron pine,
thence N. 05° 26' 175 feet to stake on Stone
Avenue, and thence with stone Avenue
S. 83° 13' E. 70 feet to beginning, being the
same conveyed to Elise Carson Bowe
(nee Elise B. Carson) by W. B. Carson, C. A.
Carson and Thomas P. Carson, by deed
dated March 11, 1911 recorded in Book 10, page
70, a life estate, therein having been
conveyed by said Elise Carson Bowe to
Chas. A. Carson and Elise W. L. Carson by
deed dated April 26, 1913, recorded in Book
18, page 191, Chas. A. Carson being now
deceased.*
