the lot described above parcel or lots of land situated

the City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid  
and being part of lot no. 29 as shown on plat of said  
Sub division recorded in the R. M. C. office of Greenville  
County in Book 1<sup>st</sup> page 421. The lot being surveyed  
is the south western portion of said lot no. 29, and  
has the following metes and bounds, to wit:
