TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, L. O. Milford, of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, SEND GREETING:  
WHEREAS, I, the said L. O. Milford,

in and by my certain note in writing, of even date with these presents, am

well and truly indebted to F. M. Todd, of Greenville County, South Carolina, for the sum of Eight Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$8,500.00) in the full and just sum of which I, the owner and holder of a mortgage executed by L. O. Milford on the aforesaid date of May 1st, 1925, covering one-half acre of land in Greenville County, Greenville, South Carolina, recorded in the office of Register of Deeds Conveyance, in Book 161 at page 7, do hereby pay to F. M. Todd, the sum of Eight Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$8,500.00) for the payment of said mortgage in full, and do hereby empower the said Register of Deeds Conveyance to enter satisfaction of the same upon the records of his office, at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually, day of December 1st, 1925.

STATUTE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and for any costs and expenses of collection, further providing for an attorney's fee of

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney established and appointed by the holder hereof, of any kind, any of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, L. O. Milford, the said F. M. Todd,

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said F. M. Todd, do hereby grant, release and convey unto him, F. M. Todd,

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said L. O. Milford,

in hand well and truly paid by the said F. M. Todd,

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said F. M. Todd,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the north side of Crescent Avenue, Ward 6, City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, and being known and designated as lot 15 and one-half of lot 16, has shown on a plat of Crescent Terrace, recorded in the office R. M. C. for County and State aforesaid, in Plat Book "E" at Page 137, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on Crescent Avenue Seventy (70) feet West from Jones Avenue and running thence N. 5-41' W 269.2 feet to rear of lots as shown on said plat; thence S. 89.07' W. ninety-six and nine-tenths (96.9) feet; thence S. 5-41' E. two hundred-seventy-six and eight-tenths (276.8) feet to a point on Crescent Avenue; thence with Crescent Avenue N. 84-40' E. ninety-six and six-tenths (96.6) feet to the beginning corner, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me, the said L. O. Milford, by W. E. Miller by his deed dated April 7, 1925, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 105 at Page 282.
