All that certain lot or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:  
Beginning at a point on the north side of Catechee Road, which point of beginning is S. 43° 15' W. 117 feet from the exact northwest corner of Catechee Road and Augusta Road; thence following the same course along the north side of Catechee Road 30 feet to an iron pipe marking an angle in the said Catechee Road; thence S. 51° 45' W. along the north side of Catechee Road, 64 feet 9 inches to an iron pipe, thence N. 14° 15' W. 123 feet six inches to an iron pipe; thence N. 43° 30' E. 25 feet 6 inches, more or less; thence S. 47° E. 114 feet 8 inches, more or less, to the point of beginning, binding north on property of Lawrence C.
