W. L. Pattonin the full and just sum of Fifteen Hundred (\$1,500.00) dollars.Dollars, to be paid One year after date

with interest thereon, from Date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid Semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Ten per cent.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. L. Patton

all of our undivided four-fifths interest in and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, on the west side of Rutherford Street,

Beginning at a point on Rutherford Street, corner of an alley, land running thence with Rutherford Street S. 0-50 W. 50 feet to stake, corner of lot owned by J. W. Batson; thence with Batson's line, S. 76-15 W. 131 feet, more or less, to fence post; thence with fence, N. 17 W. 51.2 feet, more or less, to fence post in line of property of Mary Etta Walker, et al; thence with said Walker's line, N. 69-05 E. 23.8 ft. more or less, to stake at corner of alley; thence with Alley, N. 78-40 E. 123 feet, more or less, to point on Rutherford Street, the beginning corner.
