SEND GREETING:

in the full and just sum of *Six Hundred (\$600.00) Dollars*
Dollars, to be paid *One year after date*

with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate *cancelled* per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid *annually*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the *same* rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder
hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *Ten per cent*

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same to be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or of said
debt, or) any part thereof, be collected by an attorney by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said
note reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the said *Willie Mackey &*
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *Oscar Hodges*

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me* the said *19 40*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents,
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Oscar Hodges*

that certain
piece, parcel or tract of land situated, lying and being
the State and County aforesaid, in *Paris Mountain*
Township, on *Reedy River*, known as the land con-
veyed to *Lizzie Thompson* by the heirs of *Thomas*
Thompson, adjoining lands of *Henry Wynn*, *William*
Thompson and others, metes, and bounds as follows:

Beginning on an iron pin, stone on *Reedy*
River; thence *S. 73 1/2 W. 23.80* to an iron pin; thence
S. 16 1/2 E. 5.00 to iron pin; thence *S. 16 1/4 W. 10.50* to iron
pin; thence *S. 74 1/4 E. 3.94* to iron pin; thence *N. 52 1/2 E.*
30.00 to iron pin on *Reedy River*; thence, up river *5.30*
to the beginning corner, and containing *27.9* acres,
more or less.
