WHEREAS,

I, the said *Celestia R. Evans*in and by certain *my Promissory Note* even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to*A. D. L. Barksdale*in the full and just sum of *Three thousand and 00/100 (\$3,000.00)*Dollars, to be paid *the year after date*

with interest thereon from *date* computed and paid *semi-annually* until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal, and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount so due and unpaid, together with said note, to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interest to place and the holder should place, the said note, or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor agrees to pay all costs and expenses, including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

all that certain Piece, Parcel, or lot of land situate in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Ward one of the city of Greenville, and being known and designated as a Part of lot No. 18 and a small strip of lot No. 19 of a subdivision of the Property of W. C. Cleveland, known as the Townes Street Property as shown on Plat made by ~~John~~ John Neves, in October, 1909, and recorded in the ~~R. M.
