with interest thereon, from January 6, 1921, at the rate of 5 per cent. per annum, to be
 computed and paid semi-annually.

and paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
 interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,
 who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
 added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or
 any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference
 being thereto had, as will more fully appear).

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant,
 bargain, sell and release unto the said Virginia Simkins, Committee for J. E. Simkins
 a certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated, lying
 and being in the State of South Carolina, aforesaid, in the
 City of Greenville, and known as lot No. 4, a
 flat of the H. W. Hunt property, located on Birnie Street.
 Said flat recorded in R. I. C. office for Greenville
 County in Plat book "E" page 125, having the following
 meter and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pipe
 on S. side of Birnie Street, joint corner with lot No. 3,
 and running thence with line of lot No. 3 S. 30° 19' W.
 114.7 feet to an iron pipe on line of lot No. 7; thence
 with line of lot No. 7 S. 60° 0 E. 24.25 ft to an iron pin;
 thence N. 30° 19' E. 114.4 ft to an iron pin on Birnie
 Street; thence with Birnie Street N. 60° W. 24.25 ft to the
 beginning corner, as per stone plat referred to, and
