SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *J. A. Crouch*, the said *J. A. Crouch*

in and by *7/16/1919* certain *7/16/1919* note in writing, of even date with these presents, *Mr. J. A. Crouch* well and truly indebted to *Farmers Loan & Trust Company as trustee for Mrs. Rosa B. Irvine* in the full and just sum of *Five Thousand (\$5,000.00)* Dollars, to be paid *One year after date*

with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *7%* per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid *quarterly* until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten (10%) per cent.*

besides all costs and expenses of collection to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

all that piece or lot of land in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid on the North side of Neal Street in Town and designated as Lot No. 15 in *Plat of property of David Marion Trustee recorded in Plat Book E page 212 R. M. C. Office for Greenville County* and having according to said Plat the following *width* and bounds to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of Neal street, *width* pin is 249 feet from the Northwest intersection of Province and Neal streets and running thence with line of Lot No. 14 N. 14 E. 217.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 18 E. 61 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 14 W. 207.2 feet to an iron pin on the North side of Neal street; thence with Neal street 2.76 E. 60 feet to the beginning corner, being the same land conveyed to me by Otis Garrison by deed dated September 11, 1919 and recorded in Volume 5 of page 38, and a 5 foot strip conveyed to me by David Kober, trustee, December 27, 1920 and recorded in Volume 55, page 202 R.
