bargain, sell and release unto the said *James McPherson*

*all that certain piece of land situate lying
and being in the County and State aforesaid in
Ward One of the City of Greenville, having the following
lines and bounds to wit: Beginning at a Stake on
David Street at corner of lot bounded to A. H. Taylor
and running thence with said Taylor's line 120 feet
to stake; thence in a southerly direction in a line
parallel with David Street 32 feet to a stake; thence
in a westerly direction in a line parallel with Taylor's
line 120 feet to a stake on David Street; thence
with David Street, thence with David Street 52 feet
to the beginning corner, being the corner lot of tract
conveyed to me by W. H. Rochester by deed dated
