SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said W. A. Julian

Dollars, to be paid one year from date

with interest thereon, from April 20th 1926 at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be  
computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Ten per cent  
besides all costs and expenses of collection to be  
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt,  
part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said Henry P. McGehee, his, heirs, & assigns,

all that piece parcel or lot of land in Greenville Town-  
ship, Greenville County & State aforesaid, near  
Judson Mills on the North West Corner of Easley  
Bridge Road and Georgia Avenue, and known as Plot  
no 1 on Plat made by R. E. Dalton recorded in  
Plat book E. page 259 having a frontage of 80 feet  
on north side of Easley Bridge Road with a  
depth of 183.6 feet in parallel lines, and being  
the same lot conveyed to me by Julia D. Charles
