Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book of E., Page 146, and having, according to survey made by C.H. Fuman, Jr., Engineer, September 8th, 1925, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the North side of South Main Street, which point is 130 feet East of the Northeast corner of Main and River Streets, and is the Southeast corner of a brick wall, and running thence along the Eastern face of said wall, and on N. 10° 21' W. 131.8 feet to an iron pin on Chicora Street; thence with the Southern side of Chicora Street N. 80° 15' E. 75 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 10° 15' E. 136.6 feet to a point on South Main Street, the Southeast corner of a brick wall, and joint corner of lots Nos. 12 and 13; thence along the Northern side of South Main Street N. 84° 30' W. 75 feet to the point of beginning.
