according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of THREE DOLLARS, to the said W. D. Richardson, in hand well and truly paid by the said The Prudential Insurance Company of America,

at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Prudential Insurance Company of America the following described real estate, to-wit:

All a tract of land piece, parcel or tract of land, lying being and situate in Fairview Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point marking one of the Western Corners of the within described tract, which point marks corner with lands now or formerly owned, by John Richardson and which point is in the center of the Road to Simpsonville, thence along the center of said Road, as the same meanders with the following calls: N. $22^{\circ} E.$ 11.68 chs. thence $25^{\circ} 45' E.$ 6.94 chs. and thence N. $3^{\circ} 46' E.$ 9.81 chs. to a stone, thence $S. 30^{\circ} E.$ 2.94 chs. to a stake, thence $S. 16^{\circ} 30' E.$ 6.00 chs. to a stake, thence $S. 50^{\circ} 30' E.$ 3.50 chs. to a stake, thence $S. 42^{\circ} E.$ 8.65 chs. to a stone, thence $S. 58^{\circ} 15' W.$ 38.92 chs. to a Hickory, thence N. $70^{\circ} 15' W.$ 14.68 chs. to the point and place of beginning, said tract containing 104.28 Acres and being known, as Tract No. 1, in a division of the Estate of W. D. Richardson et al. as shown by plat made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor under date of January, 1925; and being the same property conveyed to the said, W. D. Richardson, from Mrs. W. D.
