AND WHEREAS, all of said notes are dated the day of December, 1926, and are signed by J. M. Willis, and delivered before me J. G. Brown and before the same is delivered to the said company, Richmond, Virginia, in gold coin of the United States of America of present standard of weight and fineness; and it is agreed that if any of said notes are not paid at the maturity dates named therein the said note or notes so unpaid shall bear interest after maturity at the rate of eight per centum per annum.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, that I, the said J. M. Willis, (hereinafter sometimes referred to as Mortgagor), in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Southern Bond and Mortgage Co., Inc., according to the terms of said notes, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to be in hand well and truly paid by the said Southern Bond and Mortgage Co., Inc., at and before the signing of these presents, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said SOUTHERN BOND AND MORTGAGE COMPANY, INC., ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS (hereinafter sometimes referred to as Mortgeree),

All or that certain piece of land lying and situated in the Township of Greenville, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point marking the western corner of the within described tract, which point marks corner with lands now or formerly owned by Eugene Coker and W.A. Hopkins, and which point marks intersection of the Road to Fountain Inn with the Ferry Shop Road, thence along the center of said Road to Fountain Inn, as the same meanders with the following calls: N. $29^{\circ} 6' 11.8$ feet to an iron pin and thence N. $68^{\circ} 6' 502.9$ feet to an iron pin, thence leaving said road, S. $32^{\circ} 8' 34.7$ feet to an iron pin, thence N. $70^{\circ} 6' 14.7$ feet to an iron pin, thence S. $80^{\circ} 45' 8' 31.8$ feet to a point, thence N. $76^{\circ} 30' 6' 248.7$ feet to an iron pin, thence S. $44^{\circ} 34' 8' 216$ feet to an iron pin, thence S. $59^{\circ} 30' 6' 344$ feet to an iron pin, thence S. $40^{\circ} 30' 6' 424.7$ feet to an iron pin in the Old Cedar Rail Road, thence N. $82^{\circ} 10' 6' 145$ feet to an iron pin, thence S. $41^{\circ} 6' 34.3$ feet to an iron pin, thence S. $89^{\circ} 45' 6' 12.8$ feet to a black gum stump, thence S. $41^{\circ} 15' 6' 31.5$ feet to a double oak, thence S. $64^{\circ} 15' 6' 153$ feet to a pine, thence S. $50^{\circ} 45' 6' 232$ feet to a point in the center of a branch, thence along the center of said branch as the meander, S. $5^{\circ} 30' 6' 340$ feet to a point where said branch intersects with said Ferry Shop Road, thence along the center of said Ferry Shop Road, S. $63^{\circ} 30' 6' 272$ feet to an iron pin, thence leaving said road, S. $58^{\circ} 50' 6' 706$ feet to a stone, thence S. $51^{\circ} 40' 6' 968$ feet to a stone, thence S. $83^{\circ} 30' 6' 267$ feet to stone in the
