by and between P. S. Ballenger, Frank J. Osteen and J. E. Hall, and Trustees
for Sans Souci Baptist Church, an unincorporated religious
body

party of the first part, and the MECHANICS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, of Greenville, S. C., corporation, party of the second part;

WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of

Eight Thousand and no^o

(\$8,000.00)

Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight

per cent. per annum, payable weekly,

the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows to wit:

in Greenville Township, about three miles northwest of the city of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lots nos 201, 202 and 203 of the property of Colonia Company, as shown by plat thereof made by R. G. Dalton, Engineer, in 1925, and subsequently revised in 1927 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book G, pages 112-113, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin at the intersection of Franklin Road and Burcombe Road, and running thence ~~with~~ Burcombe Road N. 57-32 E. 206 feet to an iron pin, point corner of Lots 203 and 204, thence with joint line of said Lots N. 33-10 E. 200 feet to an iron pin on a ten-foot alley, thence with line of said ten-foot alley S. 57-32 E. 206 feet to an iron pin on Franklin Road, thence with line of sidewalk on said Franklin Road S. 33-00 to the point of beginning.

Being the same lot conveyed to J. E. Hall, P. S. Ballenger and J. T. McMurtry as Trustees for Sans Souci Church as follows:

Lot nos 201 by James H. Gaines by deed dated April 22, 1927 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol 113, page 210; and lots nos 202 and 203 by Colonia Company, by deed dated April 22, 1927 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol 116, page 234.

The within mortgage is executed and delivered in accordance with a resolution passed by the congregation of Sans Souci Baptist Church on the 15th day of October 1933, authorizing the within named Trustees to execute note and mortgage in the sum of \$8,000.00 for the purpose of refinancing the present mortgage of \$10,500.00 held by Mechanics Building and Loan Association, and it is distinctly herein agreed to that this mortgage shall enter into all rights of subrogation under the present existing mortgage.

I, the Rev. L. H. Miller, Pastor of Sans Souci Baptist Church of Greenville, S. C., do hereby certify that the within named P. S. Ballenger, Frank J. Osteen, and J. E. Hall are the duly elected trustees of Sans Souci Baptist Church, and that this note and mortgage is executed by them in accordance with Resolutions adopted by the congregation of Sans Souci Baptist Church on the 15th day of October 1933.
