of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, C. R. Thompson, the said C. R. Thompson, in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing date the 26th May, day of 1926,indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of \$18.00 Dollars,with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 26th day of May A. D. 1926, according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, thatthe said C. R. Thompson shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of June 1926, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of \$30.00Dollars, (\$18.00) Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the 18th Shares of Stock, and \$12.00 Dollars,Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of \$27.60 Dollars, (\$18.00)Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and \$18.60 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of \$25.20 Dollars, (\$18.00)Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and \$17.20 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of \$27.80 Dollars, (\$18.00)Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and \$18.80 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of \$27.40 Dollars, (\$18.00)Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and \$18.40 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.) Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the saidshares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by me to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made me, the said C. R. Thompsonand shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against me the said C. R. Thompson in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had and more fully appear.NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That C. R. Thompson, the said C. R. Thompson, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me the said C. R. Thompson

in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

All that piece of parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the Pac Mill Village, on Pinckney Street and known as lot No. 19 in the survey of the Hammett lands made by W. A. Hudson May 14th, 1900, plat recorded in office of Register of Deeds Conveyance for Greenville County in Book H. H. A. page 835 Said lot is bounded as follows: Beginning at the corner of lot No. 18 and running thence with Pinckney Street in an easterly direction 100 feet to corner lot No. 20; thence with line of lot No. 20 in a southerly direction 190 feet to a ten foot alley; thence with said alley in a westerly direction 100 feet to line of lot No. 18; thence with line of lot No. 18 in a northerly direction 190 feet to the beginning

M. C. for Greenville County in deed Book 101 pages 334 and 336 respectively and by E. Inman, Master, by deed dated November 10, 1924 and recorded in the said office in deed Book 67 at page 146. I sold to W. M. Burns all of said tract lying south of Hunter Bridge Road and Conveyed the same to him by deed dated November 10, 1924 recorded in deed Book 91 page 590 R. M.
