

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

That I, Lula Coleman of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, I, the said Lula Coleman in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing date the 5th day of August 1926

I am indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Nine Hundred fifty & no/100 (\$950.00) Dollars, with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 5th day of August A. D. 1926, according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that

the said Lula Coleman shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of August 1926, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of \$15.83

Dollars, (\$9.50 Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the 9 1/2 Shares of Stock and \$6.33

Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid no monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of \$14.57

Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and \$9.50 Dollars, (\$9.50 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of \$13.30

Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and \$3.80 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of \$9.50

Dollars, (\$2.53 Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and \$7.03 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of \$10.77

Dollars, (\$1.27 Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and \$9.50 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said 9 1/2 shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by me to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made I, the said Lula Coleman

and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against I the said Lula Coleman

said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, that I, the said Lula Coleman in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me

the said Lula Coleman in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

In the City of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:- Beginning at a stake on the west side of Calhoun Street, 41-2/3 feet southerly from the corner of Moore's Alley and running thence along Calhoun Street N. 18 E. 41 1/3 feet, more or less, to the corner of said alley; thence along the said alley in a line about N. 72. W 81 feet to a stake on said alley; thence in a southerly direction 40-1/2 feet to a stake 81 feet east of Calhoun Street; thence in a line about S. 72 E. 81 feet to the beginning corner on Calhoun Street, be the same distances more or less, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me Loula S. Jackson by deed dated April 26th, 1924, and recorded in Deed Book 77, page 87, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.
