WHEREAS, *I. Sallie G. Summer*, in the State aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

in and by *May 1921* certain Bond or Obligation of even date herewith stand firmly held and bound unto CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, of Greer, Greenville County, South Carolina, in the full sum of *Twelve. hundred dollars*. Dollars, conditioned for the payment of the monthly sum of *Twelve. hundred dollars*. Dollars, on the first Tuesday of each and every month succeeding the date hereof, until each and every share in the said Association shall reach the value of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS, and also for attorney's fees, in case of suit or of collection by or through an attorney, which, in addition to said debt, is hereby secured and made a lien on the premises as in and by the said Bond and Condition thereof, reference being thereto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *I. Sallie G. Summer*, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, of Greer, Greenville County, South Carolina, according to the condition of said Bond; and, also, in consideration of the further sum of THREE DOLLARS, to *me* to said *I. Sallie G. Summer*,

and, well and truly paid by the said Citizens Building and Loan Association, of Greer, Greenville County, South Carolina, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, *I. Sallie G. Summer*, the said *I. Sallie G. Summer*, have granted, bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Citizens Building and Loan Association, of Greer, Greenville County, South Carolina, all that lot of land, in said State and County, in the City of Greer, on the *North* side of *Hubert* Street.

Beginning at an iron pin or spike on Hubert Street, La Foys property, and runs thence N.  $16\frac{3}{4}$  E. 180 feet to a stake, E. J. B. Beldy's corner, thence N.  $73\frac{1}{4}$  W. 92 feet to a stake, J. B. Green's corner, thence S.  $16\frac{3}{4}$  W. 180 feet to a stake, J. B. Green's corner on Hubert Street, thence S.  $73\frac{1}{4}$  E. 92 feet to the beginning corner and containing 16. 560 square feet more or less. And being the same lot of land conveyed to me by W. P. Duncan to be recorded.
