WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Four hundred Twenty-five Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight percent per annum, payable weekly,

the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a Stake on the South side of Earle Street in the City of Greenville, at a point 63 feet from the Northeast corner of the C. F. Haynesworth lot and runs thence S. 18-30 W. 206 feet and 6 inches to a Stake; thence S. 71-20 E. 63 feet to a stake; thence N. 18-30 E. 206 feet and 6 inches to a stake on Earle Street; thence with Earle Street N. 71-20 W. 63 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same land conveyed to me by Mrs. Willie C. Williams, May, 17, 1920, and recorded in Vol. 48 page 816.

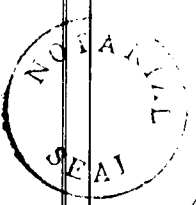
