until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to be interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *10.72*

besides all costs and expenses of collection to be added to the amount due on said note to be collected as part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear).

all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, being known as tract No 3 of the Wynn Property, as shown on a plat made by W. A. Foster, surveyor, Aug. 21st 1918, said plat being recorded in Plat Book E. at page 112, and having the following metes and bounds to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on road to the Artillery Range, corner of Edwards Land and running thence N. 76 E. 24.10 to post oak 340m; thence N. 64.40 E. 9.15 to post oak stump on; thence 11.80 $\frac{1}{4}$  E. 10.85 to stone 8m, corner of tract No. 4; thence N. 15 W. 16.30 to iron pin in said road; thence N. 36 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 7.85 to pine stump at cross roads; thence S. 86 W. 19 ch. following Artillery range road; thence S. 56 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 5.08. Along said road to the beginning corner, containing forty-four acres more or less. There is excepted theretofrom the above tract that certain tract of land containing 18.07 acres, more or less conveyed by J. L. Wynn to B. Perry Edwards by deed dated Oct 25th 1923 and recorded in Vol. 58 at page 509 in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County, the tract herein conveyed containing 25.93 acres more or less.
