 added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any
 part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference
 being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant,
 bargain, sell and release unto the said *William Goldsmith, Agent,*

*all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying
 and being in the County and State aforesaid, on Townes Street,
 in the City of Greenville, and particularly described as follows:
 Beginning at a stake corner of Lot 2, on Townes Street, and running
 thence with Townes Street S. 14 deg. 41 feet to a fence, running
 said lot S; thence with said fence 153 feet to a stake,
 then with said fence, or line of M. F. Ansel, part of the original lot 251
 purchased from H. H. Parrott; thence with line of said M. F.
 Ansel N. 15-3/4 E. 135 feet, more or less, to a stake on the line
 of H. C. Ross lot; thence with H. C. Ross lot 150 feet to the begin-
 ning corner on Townes Street, this being the same lot of land
 conveyed to my father the late H. C. Goodwin, by M. F. Ansel;
