WHEREAS, E. N. McGain, the said John McElroy,

 computed and paid Oct 17, 1924 until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or

interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount so evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who
 may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

Attorney's fees and costs of collection besides all costs and expenses of collection to be
 added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any
 part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference
 being thereto had, as will more fully appear.)

 at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant,
 bargain, sell and release unto the said Alexander Macbeth

all that brick, barrel or lot of land in the City of Greenville,
 in the County and State aforesaid having the following metes
 and bounds; beginning at a stake on the south side of Randal
 street 255 feet west from the south-west corner of Sulton
 and Randal streets, and running thence parallel to Sulton
 street S. 1-41 E. two hundred feet to a stake; thence N. 83-13 W.
 seventy-one and three tenths feet to a stake; thence N. 1-41 E
 two hundred feet to Randal street; thence, with Randal
 street, S. 83-13 E. to the beginning corner and being the same lot con-
 veyed to me, the said E. N. McGain, by A. T. Earle my Deed dated Sept.
 27, 1922, and recorded in R. M. C. office for said Deed in Vol.
 #75, at page 340. In the said lot is my present residence, and
 there is no other mortgage or encumbrance of any kind
 on said property, except a mortgage to the said Alexander
 Macbeth, for \$2500.00 dated Oct. 1, 1924 recorded in said office in
 Vol. #147, at page 160.
