with interest thereon, from Date of Note or due or demand at the rate of 6% per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually, until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 3% besides all costs and expenses of collection to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

bargain, sell and release unto the said Eva A. Andrea and Eunice J. Andrea all my one half interest in that certain lot of land situate lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, on the East side of Trade Street in the town of Greer, having the following Breeses and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a point on said Trade Street and running N 78 E. 96 feet to a point on Hill Street; thence with said Hill Street 43 feet and 6 inches to a point on said Hill Street, Merchant corner; thence along a line S 78 W 127 feet to a point on said Trade Street; thence with said Trade Street N 30 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same lot on which is located the Thompson Hardware Co. Building.
