WHEREAS, *the said Wm. H. Smith*, in and by *1926* certain, even date with these presents, *2. P. Due Basel*

in the full and just sum of *Five Thousand (\$500.00) Dollars*

Dollars, to be paid *one year after date*

with interest thereon, from *2. P. Due Basel* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid *2. P. Due Basel*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *100*

besides all costs and expenses of collection to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which are secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *2. P. Due Basel*

All that tract of land situate in the State and County aforesaid, in the City of Greenville on the south side of East Avenue between Marion and Florence Streets, upon which is now situated a fine stone cottage, designated as "1700, 1/4 E. Street Greenville, which is described as follows: Beginning at a point on the 17th Street line 29' 0" S. 20° 19' 0" E. 175' 0" feet to a stake, thence N. 20° 19' E. 175' 0" feet to the beginning as aforesaid, a plat made by G.
