of South Carolina, near the City of Greenville
being designated as lot No. 20, according to plat
made by R. E. Walton, Engineer, May 1923, of
the subdivision known as "Augusta Place" said
lot having the following Metes and bounds, to
wit:

Beginning at a stake on Augusta Street
at corner of lot No. 19, and running thence a
long line of lot No. 19, 26-30 E. 18' 7. 2 feet
to a stake at corner of lot No. 19; thence N.
63-30 E. 60 feet to a stake at corner of lot
No. 21; thence along line of lot No. 21, E. 26-30
E. 18' 8 feet to stake on Augusta Place Street;
