WHEREAS, I, the said Lerua W. Stone, in and by my certain possession of a note in writing, of even date with these presents, J. B. Ricketts, Attorney, well and truly indebted to me, in the full and just sum of Seven Hundred Dollars (\$700.00) Dollars, to be paid one year after date.

Paid in full, P. B.
with interest thereon from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of less than 10% per cent.

WITNESS, Rose, besides all costs and expenses of collection to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is agreed under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.)

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Lerua W. Stone, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

in hand well and truly paid by the said J. B. Ricketts, attorney, at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

J. B. Ricketts, Attorney, all of my right, title and interest, being an un-divided one-fourth interest in and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the South side of Pendleton Street in the City of Greenville, and described as follows to-wit. Beginning at a stake on the South side of Pendleton Street and runs thence with said street, according to the original bearings S. 69 W. 100 feet to a stake, N. 7. 1 means corner, thence S. 17 E. 200 feet with his line to a stake, thence N. 69 E. 100 feet to a stake thence N. 17 W. 200 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same lot conveyed to T.
