WHEREAS, I, the said O. A. Lucas',  
in and by my certain Prossessory  
even date with these presents, J. D. Woodside  
in the full and just sum of Seven hundred and fifty (\$750.00)  
Dollars, to be paid on or before one year after date

with interest thereon, from date of note at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be  
computed and paid semi annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of One per cent (10%)

besides all costs and expenses of collection to be

bargain, sell and release unto the said J. D. Woodside, his heirs and assigns forever  
all that tract, parcel or lot of land located near the  
City of Greenville in the County of Greenville and State  
of South Carolina, located on North Street extension of the Old  
Spartanburg Road, known and designated as lot # 3, the  
property of O. A. Lucas as shown by plat of Dalton and  
Nevels, dated September, 1926, which plat is a revision of  
lots # 4½ and 48 Overbrook Land Company, being more  
particularly described as follows:
