 with interest thereon, from the date of this instrument at the rate of 6% per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid upon demand until paid in full; interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of \$50.00, besides all costs and expenses of collection to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind, all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said All those two certain pieces parcels of lots of land in the County and state aforesaid being a portion of the Warren B. Hunt place on the Saluda River and being known and described upon plat of same made by D. W. James Engineer, May 31, 1920 as Lot no. 88 and 8A and being the following metes and bounds to wit: Lot 82.8 being at a point corner of lot no 5 & 6 and running thence N. 74 30 E. 1635 to a point in the Greenville-Pickens Road; thence with said road to a point in center of said road, thence leaving said road and running S. 16 W. 294 to a stake; thence 26-30 W. 158 to a stake thence 65-30 W. 231 to white oak; thence S. 77-15 W. 110 to point thence S. 59 1.41 to point thence S. 71 W. 1.32 to point, thence S. 86-30 E. 175 to point; thence S. 34 W. 66 to a sycamore on the banks of Saluda River; thence along said Saluda River to a point at corner of lot no. 1, leaving said River and running thence N. 76-39 E. along the Southern line of lots nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 to the beginning of corner and containing 56 and eight-tenths acres more or less.

Lot no. 8A. beginning at a point on the Greenville-Pickens road and running thence along the line of the Taylor McPhee property N. 67 E. to stone; thence N. 84 E. 299 to white oak thence N. 29 E. 319 to stone; thence S. 70 E. 353 to stake; thence S. 10 E. 785 to Mulberry thence S. 32 W. 415 to stump; thence S. 29 E. 158 to point in center of Greenville-Pickens road; thence following said road in a northwesterly direction to the beginning corner, and containing 2 3 and two-tenths acres more or less.

It is understood and agreed that the Grantees herein are to have free access to lake containing 40 acres, and known as Hunts Fish Pond.
