with interest thereon, from date at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid Semi-Annually
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal
or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten percent

added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any
part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

in consideration of the cash and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Oregon Lumber
Company according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said Oregon Lumber Company

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and
being in ward two of the City of Greenville, County and state
aforesaid, on the north side of East North Street, and having
the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at the
intersection of E. North Street and Park Avenue, and running
thence with E. North Street S. 70-30 W. 62 feet to a Pin; thence N.
19 W. 51.6 feet to a Pin on Park Avenue; thence with Park Avenue
as the line to the beginning corner, being a portion of the
same lot of land conveyed to me by O. L. and Mattie Pike
by deed dated July 28th, 1922 and recorded in the R. M. C.
office for Greenville County in Vol. 74, Page 513.
