Mississippi

Sun-Mc Comb Lateral

A 6-inch lateral pipeline, approximately 9.77 miles in length, beginning at the point of tie-in to the 30-inch main line, at milepost 641.82, in Section 27, Township 2 North, Range 7 East, and continuing in a Northwesterly direction to the point of tie-in with producers pipeline, in Section 10, Township 3 North, Range 7 East, all in Pike County, Mississippi.

Included in this lateral pipeline is a 6-inch lateral valve and receiving trap at the tie-in to the 30-inch line and a 6-inch lateral valve and sending trap at the point of tie-in with the producers pipeline.

Iva Starr Lateral

A 4-inch lateral pipeline approximately 0.20 miles in length described as follows: Beginning at a point on the Owens Corning Tap approximately 872 feet west of Hwy. 259 and continuing, between the Company's 30-inch and 36-inch main lines, in an easterly direction across Hwy. 359 for a total distance of 974 feet to a point; continuing in a northerly direction for a distance of 57 feet to the reducer in the Iva Starr M. & R. Station, all in Davidson County, South Carolina.

Pennsylvania Laterals

Oreland Lateral

A 10-inch sales lateral pipeline, approximately 6.03 miles in length described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the Company's 30-inch main pipeline, located in Lower Gwynedd Township, and continuing in a southeasterly and southwesterly direction crossing upper Dublin Township to the terminus at the Oreland M. & R. Station in Springfield Township, all in Montgomery County, Pennsylvania.

Oreland Extension

An 8-inch sales lateral pipeline, approximately 7.36 miles in length described as follows: Beginning at the Oreland M. & R. Station in Springfield Township and continuing in a southeasterly direction, passing through the Ashmead M. & R. Station to the connection with Philadelphia Electric and Gas Company pipeline, all in Montgomery County, Pennsylvania.
