## PIPE LINES

All of the following described pipe lines for the transportation and supply of natural gas acquired or constructed by the Company and not heretofore specifically described in the granting clauses of the Indenture and all real estate and rights-of-way acquired by the Company pertaining to said pipe lines or used or useful in the operation thereof:

## MAIN LINE LOOPS

## TEXAS

Four 30-inch main line loop sections in Texas, totaling approximately 36.05 miles in length described as follows:

(a) One 30-inch main line loop section totaling approximately 11.65 miles in length, beginning at Mile Post 293.31 located in the Churchill Fulshear Survey, A-29, Fort Bend County, Texas, and continuing in an easterly direction to the west end of the existing loop, located in the Sue E. Stuart Survey, A-1517, Harris County, Texas.

Included in this main line loop section is a double crossover to the main line at the west end of loop section and a main line valve and

double crossover at the east end of the loop section.

(b) One 30-inch main line loop section totaling approximately 10.44 miles in length, beginning at Mile Post 346.73 located in the M. H. Short Survey, A-1722, Harris County, Texas, and continuing in an easterly direction to the west end of the existing loop, located in the Edward King, Survey A-56, Liberty County, Texas.

Included in this main line loop section is a double crossover to the main line at the west end of loop section and a main line valve and

double crossover at the east end of the loop section.

- (c) One 30-inch loop section, totaling approximately 6.30 miles in length, beginning at the west end of the existing loop, located in the Richard Green Survey, A-197 and continuing in an easterly direction to the west end of the existing loop, located in the Julius Gilchrist Survey A-200 all in Liberty County, Texas.
- (d) One 30-inch main line loop section totaling approximately 7.66 miles in length, beginning at Mile Post 418.12 located in the Francis DeSanque Survey, A-133 and continuing in an easterly direction to the west end of the existing loop, located in the J. F. Votaw Survey, A-864, all in Jasper County, Texas.
