

MISSISSIPPI

Two 36-inch main line loops (Line "C") in Mississippi totaling approximately 58.92 miles in length described as follows:

(a) One 36-inch main line loop section (Line "C") totaling approximately 47.83 miles in length, beginning at Compressor Station 70 at Mile Post 661.67, located in Section 9, T-3-N, R-10-E, Walthall County, Mississippi and continuing in an easterly direction crossing Marion, Jefferson Davis, Marion and Jefferson Davis Counties to the tie-in to the west end of the existing loop, located in Section 10, T-7-N, R-15-W, Covington County, Mississippi.

Included in this main line loop section is a main line valve and scraper trap assembly at Compressor Station 70, a main line valve and double crossover to Line "B" at Mile Post 674.96, a main line drip at Mile Post 667.27, and a main line valve with double crossover to Line "B" at Mile Post 692.05.

(b) One 36-inch main line loop section (Line "C") totaling approximately 11.09 miles in length, beginning at Mile Post 767.32, located in Section 35, T-2-N, R-16-E, and continuing in an easterly direction to the Mississippi—Alabama State Line, located in Section 16, T-2-N, R-18-E, all in Clarke County, Mississippi.

Included in this main line loop section is a main line valve with double crossover to Line "B" at Mile Post 775.72.

ALABAMA

Three 36-inch main line loop sections in Alabama, totaling approximately 90.63 miles in length described as follows:

(a) One 36-inch main line loop (Line "C") section totaling approximately 18.40 miles in length beginning at the Mississippi—Alabama State Line, located in Section 11, T-12-N, R-5-W, and continuing in an easterly direction to the west end of the existing loop, located in Section 3, T-13-N, R-2-W, all in Choctaw County, Alabama.

Included in this loop section is a main line valve with single crossover to Line "B" at Mile Post 784.66.

(b) One 36-inch main line loop (Line "C") section totaling approximately 38.19 miles in length, beginning at Mile Post 837.58, located in Section 14, T-16-N, R-5-E, Marengo County, Alabama, and continuing in an easterly direction to the west end of the existing loop, located in Section 2, T-18-N, R-11-E, Dallas County, Alabama.

Included in this loop section is a crossover at the beginning of the loop section, a main line valve with double crossover to Line "B" at
