in hand well and truly paid by the said PIEDMONT SAVINGS AND TRUST COMPANY, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and, by these presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said PIEDMONT SAVINGS AND TRUST COMPANY, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

Fronting on Pinckney Street in the City of Greenville and being known as lot #21 on plat of W. H. Henderson bearing date July 8 1908, and having the following notes and bounds, courses and distances to wit:  
Beginning at an iron pin on Pinckney Street at corner of land now or formerly owned by W. H. Markley; and running 56 E. 175 feet to an iron pin corner of lot #14 on said plat; thence N. 34 W. 55 ft. to an iron pin on line between said lots #21 and 14; thence S. 56 W. 175 ft. to an iron pin on Pinckney Street; thence S. 34 W. 55 ft. along Pinckney Street to the beginning corner.
