

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I George Warren  
of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, I, the said George Warren  
in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing date the 15th day of February 1927

I am indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate,  
duly incorporated under the laws of such State) in the sum of Eight hundred fifty (\$850.00) Dollars,

with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 15th day of February A. D. 1927,  
according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that

I the said George Warren shall pay or cause to be paid to the said  
Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City, S.C., monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of February  
1927, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of fourteen and 7/100

Dollars, Eight and 5/100 Dollars,  
being the regular monthly installment payable on Eight hundred and one Shares of Stock, and five and 7/100

Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance (or loan) under thereon, and there have been made twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the  
sum of thirteen and 3/100 Dollars, (Eight and 5/100

Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and four and 53/100 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due);  
for the next twenty months the sum of Eleven and 9/100 Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and three and 4/100

Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of ten and 7/100  
Dollars, (Eight and 5/100 Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and

sum of nine and 27/100 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the  
monthly payment on said shares of stock and one and 13/100 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said eight and 1/2  
shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by me to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made me, the said

George Warren and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against me the said George Warren  
said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said George Warren  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company,  
according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me

the said George Warren  
in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is  
hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and  
Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

In the city of Greenville, beginning at a stake on the north side of Douthit Street, one hundred and fifty two feet east of the corner of Leach and Douthit Streets, and running thence in a northerly direction, midway between the two tenant houses and through the well on the Jackson Property for a distance of ninety six feet to an iron pipe; thence in a westerly direction (parallel to Douthit Street) forty seven feet to an iron pipe; thence in a southerly direction ninety seven feet to an iron pipe on Douthit Street; thence along said Douthit Street in an easterly direction fifty two feet, be each of the said distances more or less, to the beginning Point; and  
being the same lot of land conveyed to me by deed, of Louisa S. Jackson, dated September 9, - , not not re- corded.
