WHEREAS, Jamer Barton, the said Jamer Barton in and by myself certain note or obligation, bearing date the 12th day of July 1928

indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Four hundred (\$400.00) Dollars, with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 12th day of July A. the said Jamer Barton shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of July 1928, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of Six + 33/100 (\$6.33) Dollars, (\$4.00 Dollars,

being the regular monthly installment payable on the four Shares of Stock, and Two + 33/100 (\$2.33) Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of Five + 87/100 (\$5.87) Dollars, (\$4.00 Dollars,

Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and One + 87/100 (\$1.87) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of Five + 40/100 (\$5.40) Dollars, (\$4.00 Dollars,

Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and One + 40/100 (\$1.40) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Four + 93/100 (\$4.93) Dollars, (\$4.00 Dollars,

Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and Four + 93/100 (\$4.93) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Four + 70/100 (\$4.70) Dollars, (\$4.00 Dollars,

Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and Four + 70/100 (\$4.70) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.) Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said four shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid, shall by me to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made me, the said

the said Jamer Barton in hand well and truly paid by me and The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that me or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:
