Computed + Paid until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of
principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder
hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of \$50.00

besides all costs and expenses of collection to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That Robert Poole
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Dr. A. White

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said
Robert Poole

in hand well and truly paid by the said Dr. A. White

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Dr. A. White, his heirs and assigns

forever; all that certain Piece, Parcel or lot of land
situated, lying and being in Chick Springs Township,
near the Town of Taylors, adjoining lands of the
Aiken's Chapel Baptist Church. (colored) and the
Taylors Colored School Property and having the
following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a stone, the corner of the Property
of the said Church, and running thence N. 33 1/2 E.
6.53 chains to an iron Pin on Enoree River; thence
up the river about 1.85 chains to an iron Pin; thence
S. 33 1/2 W. 6.53 chains to a stone on the line of the
said School Property; thence N. 86 E. 1.85 chains to the
beginning corner, containing one (1) acres, more or
less, and being the same plot of land conveyed
to me by Ida J. Aiken by deed dated Oct. 5th, 1927,
