WHEREAS, I, the said *Humphrey D. Wolfe*, in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to Ray H. Bassman, Receiver for the Bank of Commerce, Greenville, S.C. Two Thousand Fifty (\$2,050.00) in the full and just sum of Dollars, to be paid as follows: \$100.00 payable June 15, 1928 and \$100.00 on the 15th day of each and every consecutive month thereafter until paid in full.

with interest thereon, from date until paid in full computed and paid at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *10% of amount due* besides all costs and expenses of collection to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

Bassman, Receiver* according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said *Ray H. Bassman, Receiver* at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Ray H. Bassman, Receiver for*

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stake on the south side of Quist Avenue 123 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet east of Asterie lot and running thence along Quist Avenue S. 80-15E. 66 $\frac{2}{3}$ feet to a stake; thence S. 9-45W. 160 feet to a stake; thence N. 80-15W. 66 $\frac{2}{3}$ feet to a stake; thence N. 9-45E. 160 feet to the beginning corner.
