*plus all costs and expenses of collection to be added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said E. Godfrey Webster:

All that Piece, Parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina in the City of Greenville, on the North side of Broft Street and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a stake on the North side of Broft Street a distance of 217 feet and 6 inches east of the northeast corner of Broft and Robinson Streets and at the joint corner of Lots nos. 22 and 24 and thence running along the joint line of said lots N. 1-41 E. 200 feet to a stake on alley; thence along the line of said alley N. 83-13 W. 54 feet to a stake; thence S. 1-41 W. 200 feet to a stake on Broft Street; thence along Broft Street S. 83-13 E. 54 feet to the beginning corner, being extreme eastern portion of lot no. 32 of Section B. of the Stone Land Company Property as is shown on a Plat recorded in Plat Book "A" at Page 341, R. M. C. office for Greenville County, being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Eva May Green by deed of even date, the same not yet recorded.

This mortgage is intended to rank as a lien junior to the lien of a mortgage executed this day by me to the Piedmont Savings and Trust Co. of Greenville S. C., in the sum of Nine hundred and fifty Dollars.

This mortgage is given as additional security to the note above referred to.
