

AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION OF LOAN NO. 150912

WHEREAS, there remains unpaid on a certain note executed and delivered by William L. Wylie to The Prudential Insurance Company of America, secured by a mortgage upon real estate in Greenville County, South Carolina, dated June 8th, 1925, and recorded in said County on June 9th, 1925, in Volume 123 of mortgages on Page 251, in the sum of Twenty Nine Hundred & Seventy Five (\$2,975.00) Dollars, with interest from June 8th, 1930, and,

WHEREAS, title to the mortgaged premises is now vested in Williams L. Wylie subject to said mortgage and,

WHEREAS, the said Insurance Company has been requested to make said note payable as hereinafter agreed, which it has consented to do in consideration of the payments to be made as herein provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, the said William L. Wylie hereby agree to pay the principal sum remaining due as aforesaid as follows:

One Hundred Seventy-Five (\$175.00) Dollars on June 8th, 1931; One Hundred Seventy-Five (\$175.00) Dollars on June 8th, 1932; One Hundred Seventy-Five (\$175.00) Dollars on June 8th, 1933; One Hundred Seventy-Five (\$175.00) Dollars on June 8th, 1934; And the balance of Twenty-Two Hundred Seventy Five (\$2,275.00) Dollars on June 8th, 1935.

with interest thereon from June 8th, 1930, to June 8th, 1935, at the rate of six (6%) per cent. per annum, payable semi-annually; and with interest after maturity as set forth in said note.

PREPAYMENT PRIVILEGE:

Privilege is given to make additional payments on the principal sum of this note in sums of \$100 or multiples thereof, on any interest maturity date.

And the parties to this agreement hereby consent to said extension and agree that said mortgage shall continue a first lien upon said premises, and that said note and mortgage and all their covenants and conditions shall remain in force except as herein modified.

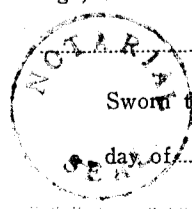
