

AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION OF LOAN NO. 164997

WHEREAS, there remains unpaid on a certain note executed and delivered by Hattie Jansell

to

The Prudential Insurance Company of America, secured by a Mortgage upon real estate in

Greenville County, South Carolina, dated January 5, 1926, and recorded in said County on January 5, 1926 in Volume 171 of Mortgages on Page 17, in the sum of

Eight Thousand and no/100 Dollars, with interest from January 5, 1926, and,

WHEREAS, title to the mortgaged premises is now vested in Hattie Jansell

subject to said Mortgage and,

WHEREAS, the said Insurance Company has been requested to make said note payable as hereinafter agreed, which it has consented to do in consideration of the payments to be made as herein provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, the said Hattie Jansell

hereby agree to pay the principal sum remaining due as aforesaid as follows:

\$200. on January 5, 1932; \$200. on July 5, 1932; \$200. on January 5, 1933; \$200. on July 5, 1933; \$200. on January 5, 1934; \$200. on July 5, 1934; \$200. on January 5, 1935; \$200. on July 5, 1935; and the balance of \$6,400. on January 5, 1936; with interest thereon from January 5, 1926, to January 5, 1936 at the rate of 5 1/2 per cent. per annum, payable semiannually; and with interest after maturity as set forth in said note.

PREPAYMENT PRIVILEGE:

Privilege is given to make additional payments on the principal sum of this note in sums of \$100. or multiples thereof, on any interest maturity date.

And the parties to this agreement hereby consent to said extension and agree that said Mortgage shall continue a first lien upon said premises, and that said note and Mortgage and all their covenants and conditions shall remain in force except as herein modified.
