

1. This Agreement, made in duplicate this 19th day of September A.D. 1927, by and between Pearl G. Bull of the County of Greenville and State of S.C. party of the first part, and the Penn Mutual Life Insurance Company, Philadelphia, Pa., a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Pennsylvania party of the second part:
2. Witnesseth. That whereas the said party of the second part is holder and owner of a promissory note for \$2750.00, now reduced to \$2250.00 made by Thomas A. Baugh, and assumed by Pearl G. Bull, ^{dated Oct 3, 1922} payable to the order of The Penn Mutual Life Insurance Company, and which note is secured by a mortgage on real estate in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina described as follows, to-wit:
 All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land situate on the west side of Sumner Street in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville State of South Carolina, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the West side of Sumner Street, 151 feet 9 inches from the S.W. corner of Puddleton and Sumner Streets, and running thence N. 72-42 W. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 17-18 W. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 72-42 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on Sumner Street; thence with said Street N. 17-18 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner, as shown by plat made by Will News, Surveyor on 20 May, 1915, and being the same lot conveyed to T.A. Baugh by Marion B. Leach by deed dated June 17, 1919 and recorded in Vol 45 page 542, said mortgage being filed for record in the R.M.C. of said County on the 24th day of October A.D. 1922 in Book 126 on page 5.
3. And whereas, the said party of the first part is the present owner of said property.
4. And whereas, at the special instance and request of the said party of the first part the said party of the second part has extended and does hereby extend the time of payment of the note as follows: (Over)
