

of said contour line, about 45-00 feet (measured in a straight line) to where said contour line crosses the western boundary line of the Baring Tract, being the seventh corner of the tract above described; thence with said Baring line, South $5^{\circ} 30'$ West to a point ab- or opposite the center of Green River, being the sixth corner of the tract above described; thence up and with the meanders of said river, about 1100 feet to a stake in line of E. F. Stator Seven-Acre tract, south side of river; thence South 23° East with said line to the beginning, containing 20 acres, more or less.

Fifth Tract:

All those certain tracts, parcels or lots of land lying and being in the county of Polk, in the State of North Carolina, more particularly described as follows:

First Lot.

Beginning on an iron pin on the South bank of Green River, corner of lands of Mrs. F. E. Jones, land of C. H. Ruppe and the David Thompson tract of Manufacturers Power Company, thence along the Ruppe-Thompson line N. 88.30° W. 295 feet to stake; thence N. 48.05° W. 530 feet to stake near south end of dam as located; thence N. 25.15° W. 334 feet to stake; thence N. 24.07° E. 141 feet to stake; thence N. 14.45° E. 274 feet to stake on contour elevation 925 (reference U. S. G. S. B. M. 105-3, near Hamilton Bridge); thence with the meanders of said contour elevation, 925 feet, in a westerly and southerly direction, over the lands deeded by C. H. Ruppe and others to Joseph Lee, September 26, 1907, and recorded in Register's Office, Polk County, in Book 24, page 36, and from David A. Thompson and others to Joseph Lee, December 21st, 1908, and recorded in Book 26, page 560, Office Register of Deeds, Polk County, to a small branch; thence crossing said branch and continuing with said contour elevation 925 feet in a north westerly direction to line between the Thompson Tract and lands of Joseph Melton; thence with Melton's line N. $1\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ E. about 700 feet to Green River; thence with the said river, in a north westerly direction, about 15-00 feet to the line between lands of Joseph Melton and the J. B. Turner Tract; thence with said Melton line S. $\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. about 25-0 feet to point on contour elevation 925 feet; thence with the meanders of said contour line
