Tower line extending from Tuxedo, North Carolina, to Spartanburg, South Carolina, being 34.1 miles in length.

Tower line extending from Turners Station North Carolina, to Campobello, South Carolina, being 15.1 miles in length.

Pole line extending from Campobello, South Carolina, to Chesnee, South Carolina, being 17.4 miles in length.

Pole and tower line extending from Spartanburg, South Carolina, to Laurens, South Carolina, being 33.1 miles in length.

Pole line extending from Spartanburg, South Carolina, to Clifton, South Carolina, being 8.4 miles in length.

Pole line extending from Saxon Mills sub-station to Howard Street sub-station in the City of Spartanburg, South Carolina, being 1.8 miles in length.

Fourteenth Lot.

Also all the right, title and interest of the Broad River Power Company in and to a certain transmission (pole) line, extending from Spartanburg, South Carolina, to Greer, South Carolina, being 15.1 miles in length.
