paid, when the balance will be due and payable. The payments  
to be applied first to interest and then pro rata to principal  
until paid in full. Interest at the rate of 6% to be computed and paid on  
with interest thereon from July 1, 1937 at the rate of 5 1/2%.

per centum to be computed and paid annually, until paid in full; all

R. M. C. Office for said county to wit.

Beginning at the northwest corner of Washington  
Road and Williams Street and running thence with  
Williams Street N. 15° 25' 27. 482.33 feet to iron pin at the  
corner of lot conveyed by Judie Poe Brawley to Joseph  
E. Surrine; thence at right angle to Williams street in  
a westerly direction along the line of said lot 138.5 feet
