WHEREAS, I, F. J. Langley,
in and by my certain note in writing, of
even date with these presents, well and truly indebted to

Green Bank & Trust Co. Greenville, S. C. its successors or assigns
in the full and just sum of one hundred dollars
Dollars, to be paid as stated therein

with interest thereon, from maturity at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Ten per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Green Bank & Trust Co.

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, situate and being in the County and State aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds. Beginning at Oak Corner near the branch, Corner of J. M. Langley, J. R. Childress, and D. J. Loftice; thence straight line down to rock corner near Fisk pond; thence course to a stone corner in pasture; thence straight to forks of road leading out to G. P. Styles old place, thence leading South course with road to Tom Styles fire; thence with line running East to Blackgum corner on long branch; thence up branch about 20 steps to rock corner; thence with line between J. M. Langley and Max Andrews to old foot oak stump now a rock; thence with road to rock corner between J. M. Langley and J. R. Childress; thence with road running toward J. M. Langley's home place to stone; thence with Childress line to stone; thence South to stone; thence West with hedge fence to beginning corner, containing about 135 acres, more or less, and J. M.
