\$500.00 Dec. 1, 1930 and 1/3 of \$500.00, Dec. 1, 1931.

with interest thereon from Feb. 10, 1928 at the rate of 10 per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid July 1st each year Mar. 24  
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
